Members

 2. One person in an administrative role with faculty appointment
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Chair

Designated annually by the President from the Committee membership

Charge

The Presidential Clinical Excellence Award was established by the Executive Committee to recognize and honor current Health Science Center clinicians who have distinguished themselves by their exemplary and sustained clinical expertise and care for patients.

1. Establish criteria for the granting of the award and review the criteria as necessary.
 2. Establish the format in which nominations must be submitted.
 3. Solicit nominations for the award.
 4. Select no more than three candidates to receive the award.
 5. Submit the name(s) of the candidate(s) to the President.
