
Bank Robbery, Medical Center Area

This warning is provided to inform and to educate the campus community of reported crimes that have happened on or near our campus and also to comply with the federal requirements of the Clery Act.

Due to the nature of this type of crime, I wanted to make our community aware that today, April 16, 2015, at approximately 10:45 am San Antonio Police Department (SAPD) dispatched officers to the BBVA Compass Banks located at 7575 Wurzbach Rd. for a robbery.

UT Police and San Antonio Police conducted a search of the area and were unable to locate the suspect.

The suspect description was a Black Male 6' blue ball cap, black mask, cream colored long sleeved shirt, black pants The suspect was last seen fleeing in a Silver Nissan towards Babcock Rd. No other description is available.
