



Timeline for GSBS Degree Conferral on August 27, 2021

For In Absentia

Students eligible for In Absentia must enroll in INTD 1000

1 month prior to defense	Upload initial draft of dissertation/thesis to TurnItIn. Submit dissertation/thesis with initial TurnItIn report to the Supervising Professor.
2 weeks prior to defense	Submit dissertation/thesis to the Research Supervisory Committee.
*1 week prior to defense	<p>The following should be completed 1 week prior to defense:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Request for Final Oral Exam in IMPACT <i>*This form should be completely signed by all approvers 1 week before the defense date.</i> Upload abstract, vita and CV with above form in IMPACT <p><i>*Failure to have a completed form within 1-week <u>will</u> result in the rescheduling of the defense.</i></p>
May 24 – June 25, 2021	<p>To be eligible for In Absentia, the defense must occur within these dates.</p> <p><i>*Final committee-approved version of dissertation/thesis must be submitted to ProQuest within 2 weeks following defense date.</i></p>
August 6, 2021	<p>Last day to submit the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The signed “Report on Final Oral” (Form 43/Form 41) The signed Approval Page (with original signatures) Submit Final Upload into TurnItIn Submit Final approved version of dissertation/thesis to ProQuest <p><i>Submit forms to Amber Yuker in the Graduate Dean’s Office for approval by the Dean.</i></p>
August 13, 2021	The Graduate Faculty Council (GFC) votes to approve degree.
August 27, 2021	GSBS Degree Conferral Date (No Commencement Ceremony)
