

Mastectomy

+/- reconstruction

Immediate or delayed

- Simple
- Skin-sparing
- Nipple-sparing



Oncoplastics

- Approach
- Team-based
- Example of oncoplastic options with lumpectomy
 - Hidden scar
 - Recreation of breast mound
 - Reduction
 - Lift (mastopexy)
 - Contralateral balancing procedure
 - Scar revisions & fat grafting




Oncoplastics

- Example of oncoplastic options with mastectomy
 - Nipple-sparing or skin-sparing mastectomy with immediate reconstruction
 - Implant-based
 - Autologous tissue


Types of Skin-sparing Mastectomy Incisions







Implant-based reconstruction


- Tissue-expanders
- Direct-to-implant








