

Clinical Competency Committee Gastroenterology & Nutrition

The CCC is comprised of members of the active teaching faculty, which conducts regularly scheduled meetings and reviews the progress of every resident in the program. The frequency of meetings must be at least bi-annually. The CCC is advisory to the program director. It considers all written rotational and other evaluations, and discusses any non-congruence between written evaluations and their experiences with each resident. The provision of frank verbal feedback by the CCC to the program director and chair is an important process for determining whether the resident's performance is accurately revealed in the rotational evaluations. The CCC discussion and recommendations of promotion/graduation/disciplinary actions are communicated to the program director for feedback to the resident.

The CCC consists of a chair, 3 core faculty and the program director. The program coordinator attends to provide administrative support and to document deliberation and decisions.

The CCC will maintain written minutes, using GME template form policy 3.7, which will list the names of all residents considered and all CCC member attendance.

If a resident's progress is not satisfactory, he/she may be subject to an altered level of academic status as outlined in GME Policy 2.8, 2.9 and 2.10. All adverse actions will be communicated to the resident by the CCC chair and program director.
