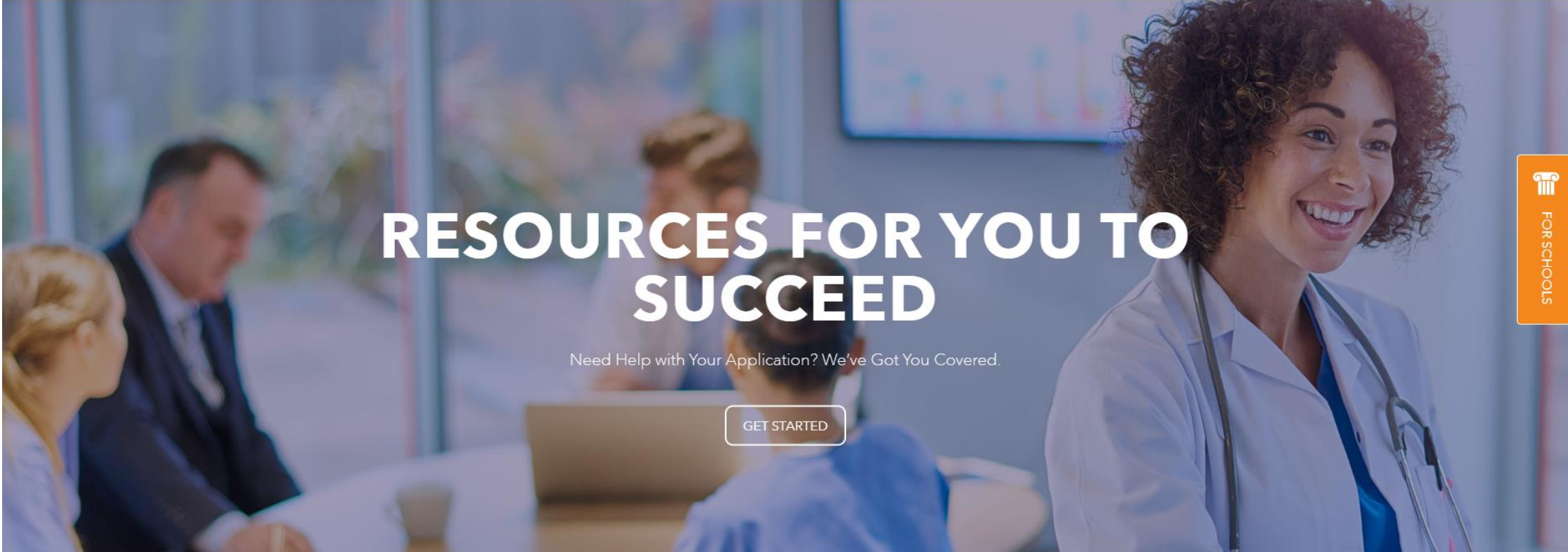

# Application Process

NursingCAS Must Receive the Following by the Deadline:

- Completed application
- Recommendation forms from three professional references
- Official transcripts from all colleges you have attended

Recommendation Forms:

- Your references will be sent a recommendation form to submit to NursingCAS
- Use professional references that can speak on your abilities in a clinical setting
- Ensure your references submit their form and letter before the deadline

Interview:

- After the application deadline, the Office of Admissions will start an initial review of applications.
- Interview offers will be sent to applicants after this initial review
- Interviews are held online through [www.KiraTalent.com](http://www.KiraTalent.com)



# International Applicants

In addition to meeting program admission requirements, applicants who have attended a foreign institution are required to submit the following documents directly to the Office of Admissions at the School of Nursing when applying for admission:

- Official course-by-course foreign transcript evaluation
  - For approved credentialing services, visit [www.naces.org](http://www.naces.org)
- TOEFL or IELTS score
  - Scores must be within the previous 2 years
  - ***If previous undergraduate and/or graduate degrees were earned from a US institution, TOEFL or IELTS scores are not required.***
