- Doctorate of Physical Therapy Degree (3 years)

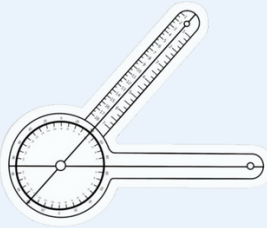


WHAT DO PHYSICAL THERAPIST DO?
