## PTCAS Application Requirements

- ☐ Upload Supplemental Application
- ☐ Send GRE scores to PTCAS (Code 7558)
- 2 Letters of Reference via PTCAS Application (min. 1 from licensed Physical Therapist)
- Personal Written Statement/Essay (found in PTCAS)
- ☐ Personal Resume
- ☐ Minimum of 50 observations hours with a licensed Physical Therapist
- ☐ Transcript Entry of all college level courses
- ☐ Send all college/university transcripts to PTCAS
- ☐ *Institutions Outside of U.S.*: Send NACES courseby-course evaluation to PTCAS.
- ☐ *International Applicants:* Submit TOEFL Scores; min. 560 (paper), or 68 (internet) to PTCAS.

To be eligible for admission review, all required documents must be uploaded or mailed to PTCAS for processing. To meet the October deadline, PTCAS application must be submitted and PTCAS status must be "Complete."

GRE scores must be submitted prior to the program start date in May 2022. Prerequisite courses may be in-progress until May 2022. All other materials must be submitted prior to deadline to be eligible for review.

Bursar prior to application deadline.
