Application Period for MOT Class of 2016 Program Entry: August 1 – November 1, 2015

Admission Requirements Checklist – Deadline: November 1, 2015

- ✓ Completion of a bachelor degree from a regionally accredited college/university by the end of the fall semester prior to 2016 summer admission.
- ✓ **<u>Completion</u>** of <u>all prerequisite coursework</u> by the end of the fall semester *prior* to 2016 summer admission.
 - Human Anatomy Lecture & Laboratory (4 semester credit hours)
 - Human Physiology Lecture & Laboratory (4 semester credit hours)
 - Physics I Lecture (3 semester credit hours)
 - Kinesiology Lecture Principles & Dynamics of Movement (3 semester credit hours)
 - Abnormal Psychology Lecture (3 semester credit hours)
 - Developmental Psychology Lecture (3 semester credit hours)
 - Sociology Lecture <u>OR</u> Anthropology Lecture (3 semester credit hours)
 - Statistics (3 semester credit hours)
 - Medical Terminology course (1 semester credit hour)

For specific prerequisite course equivalencies, please utilize the approved UT Health Science Center at San Antonio <u>MOT Prerequisite Equivalency Chart.</u>

- ✓ Prerequisite GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- ✓ <u>Minimum</u> of 40 hours of observation, volunteer, or employment under the general supervision of a *licensed* Occupational Therapist – documented using the <u>MOT Documentation of Experience</u> form.
- ✓ Two Letters of Recommendation See <u>OTCAS</u> for instructions
- ✓ International Applicants ONLY: Submit Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) scores with at least a score of 560 (paper) 68 (internet) See <u>OTCAS</u> for instructions

Application Requirements Checklist – Deadline: November 1, 2015

- ✓ <u>Occupational Therapist Centralized Application Service</u> (OTCAS) completed online application
- ✓ <u>Completion of the Occupational Therapy Supplemental Application</u> emailed to <u>SHPwelcome@uthscsa.edu</u>
- ✓ All Official Transcripts from <u>each</u> college/university –See <u>OTCAS</u> for instructions (<u>Do not</u> send transcripts to UT Health Science Center San Antonio)
- ✓ Note: Transcripts from institutions outside the United States must be submitted in the original language to a <u>NACES Members Evaluation agency</u> for an English translation and then must be submitted to CASPA.
- ✓ Two Letters of Recommendation completed See <u>OTCAS</u> for instructions
- ✓ Observation Hours (minimum 40 hours) with a licensed Occupational Therapist documented using the <u>MOT</u> <u>Documentation of Experience</u> form – see <u>OTCAS</u> for instructions
- ✓ Payment of the \$60.00 non-refundable supplemental application fee via the online portal <u>CashNet</u> (https://commerce.cashnet.com/uthscsasf).

All documents and payments must be completed and <u>received by November 1, 2015</u> for admission in May 2016.

Required Documents (if you are accepted) to the Master of Occupational Therapy program:

If you are made an <u>official offer</u> for the UT Health Science Center at San Antonio Master of Occupational Therapy (MOT) program, <u>all of the following items are required</u>:

- Non-refundable \$250.00 SHP Tuition Deposit to secure each student's seat for the MOT Class of 2016 entry. Directions for this process will be sent to accepted students.
- Completion of a background check. Directions for this process will be sent to accepted students.
- Completion of a Health Provider CPR course approved by the <u>American Heart Association</u>. additional instructions coming soon
- All official documents must be completed and received *at least 30 days prior to Registration* by the UT Health Science Center San Antonio:
 - <u>All</u> Immunization records: Immunization requirements can be found at the <u>UT Health Science Center at</u> <u>San Antonio Student Health Center Web Page</u> – see form for full instructions and send to the Student Health Center

Note: The Hepatitis B Immunization series can takes between 4 to 6 months to complete.

- ✓ Evidence of current health insurance showing dates of coverage. Unless proof of proper insurance coverage is provided before the first day of classes, students will be charged for a health insurance policy through the university. The fee for this policy is non-removable once the payment due date passes and is non-refundable once paid. Directions for this process will be sent to accepted students.
- No exceptions. Please plan early as some documents can take up to 6 months to complete.
